WHAT IS BLOOD CANCER?

Blood cancers are diseases that affect the production and function of blood cells. Many of these cancers occur in the bone marrow where blood is made. Cells in the bone marrow mature and develop into three types of blood cells: red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets. Uncontrolled growth of abnormal or cancerous blood cells interrupts the normal cell development process and prevents the blood from performing its day-to-day function. We treat several types of blood cancer diseases including lymphoma, leukemia and myeloma.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED PHYSICIANS

Our statewide network of oncologists includes nationally recognized experts in all cancers, including blood cancers. Our oncologists are very active in clinical research, helping to develop new therapies. They publish numerous articles in peer-reviewed medical journals describing their findings in these trials. Because of their ongoing participation in clinical research, they are able to offer the latest therapies for patients with blood cancers.

As Colorado's only nationally recognized, community-based research program, our patients have access to clinical trials in all major cancer types, including blood cancers. RMCC has played a role in more than 100 FDA-approved cancer therapies. As a part of US Oncology Research, we have conducted more than 1,600 trials with more than 400 active at any given time. We have experienced investigators and dedicated staff specializing in Phase I-IV oncology clinical trials.
